### Instruction:

- 1) Purchase a hat entry pin **AND** fill out the RMSA Top Dawg Registration form.

  - \*4) Submit this form on RMSA website or mail to RMSA
- \* Need to be done within 20 days of being speared. If passed 20 days, it becomes ineligible.

Take a close-by photo/video: (Photoshopped is automatically disqualified and banned.)

- 1) Place and flatten the fish on the surface.
  - 2) Place and flatten the tape measurement next to the fish (both require to be fully visible).
  - 3) Place the Hat Entry Pin next to the fish (for example, see display as long as it is fully visible).
  - \*\*4) Place any digital devices that displays date and time next to the tape measurement (see display).
- \*\*Can be substituted with newspaper or any source to legitimately display the date you speared.
